OF NONSEGREGATED FACILITIES

Bidders and Offerors are cautioned as follows: By signing this Bid or Offer, the Bidder or Offeror will be deemed to have signed and agreed to the provision of the "Certification of Nonsegregated Facilities" in this solicitation. The certification provides that the Bidder or Offeror does not maintain or provide for his employees facilities which are segregated on a basis of race, creed, color, or national origin, whether such facilities are segregated by directive or on a de facto basis. The certification also provides that he will not maintain such segregated facilities. Failure of a Bidder or Offeror to agree to the Certification of Nonsegregated Facilities will render his Bid non-responsive to the terms of solicitation involving awards of contracts exceeding \$10,000 which are not exempt from the provision of the Equal Opportunity clause.
